A Year of Growth

The 2025-2026 year was another positive step forward for Cycling NWT. Highlights included securing Community Sport for All Initiative (CSAI) funding, purchasing a new equipment trailer, planning a HopOn Instructor Training course for 2026, delivering the Territorial Championships Race Series, continuing the Yellowknife Fatbike Race Series, and preparing athletes for the 2029 Canada Games.

Cycling NWT also remained actively engaged with Cycling Canada through national meetings and working groups, while continuing to grow its online presence with more than **120,000 social media views** during the year.

Financial Report

Members approved the 2025-2026 financial statements. The organization remains focused on investing in community programming, events, coach development, and cycling opportunities across the Northwest Territories while maintaining a stable financial position.

Planning is well underway for:

- Paulatuk cycling equipment delivery in partnership with the Canadian Coast Guard.
- HopOn Instructor Training.
- The 2026 Territorial Championships.
- Community Bike Rodeos.
- Expanded community training rides and volunteer ride leaders.
- New partnerships with organizations including the Yellowknife Mountain Bike Club.
